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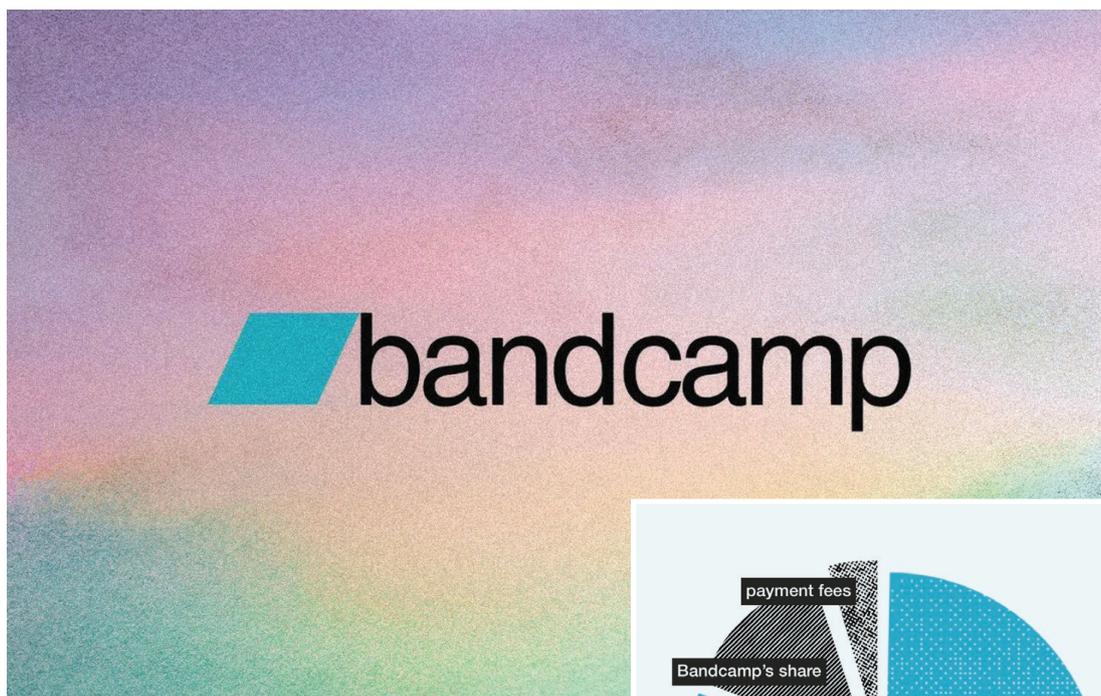

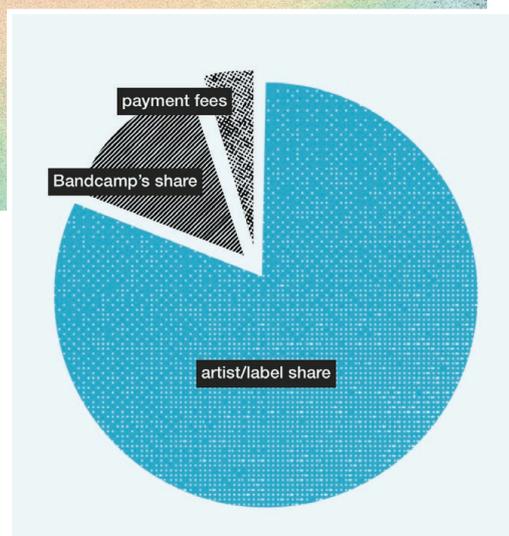

Platform & Mission

Bandcamp launched in 2008 as an independent-focused direct-to-consumer storefront for music and merchandise sales. It allows artists and labels to set prices, keep control of their work and connect directly with fans. The platform **charges a 15% commission, dropping to 10% after \$5,000 in sales** and has earned a reputation as the place to be **for independent artists seeking more autonomy** in the digital music economy.

Bandcamp's core mission is to **empower artists to monetise their own work** on their terms without "middlemen" by providing a transparent, artist-friendly infrastructure which includes control over pricing, fan data and storefront design. Bandcamp has also won hearts with its commission-free 'Bandcamp Fridays' promotion, during which 100% sales revenues go to the artists and labels.



Scale & Economic Reach

Bandcamp supports an enthusiastic global community of over **47 million fans and eight million artists**. Its community has a **strong interest in independent music**, digital and physical formats, and a preference for supporting artists directly. Statista indicates that **Bandcamp is more popular among male users** compared to female users.

Artist earnings through the platform have surpassed \$1.5bn, with around \$120m

generated through Bandcamp Fridays alone since 2020. The platform sees an average of over 100,000 new users joining each month. **Around half of the transactions on the platform involve merchandise**, including more than 30m merch items sold, totalling \$564m in revenue. **Vinyl sales have increased by 438%, cassette sales by 232% and t-shirt sales by 250% over the past five years**, showing the strong demand for physical goods.

Artist-Friendly Features

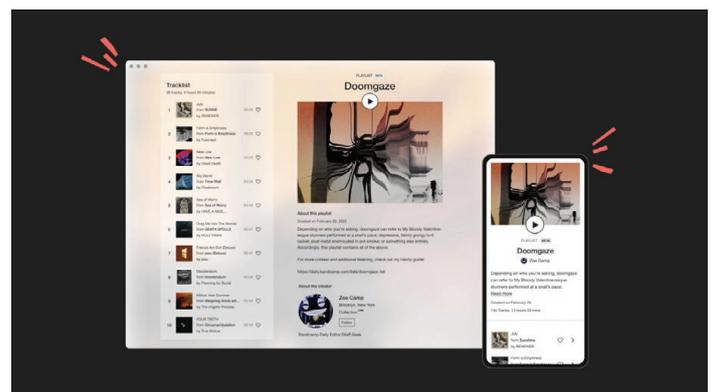
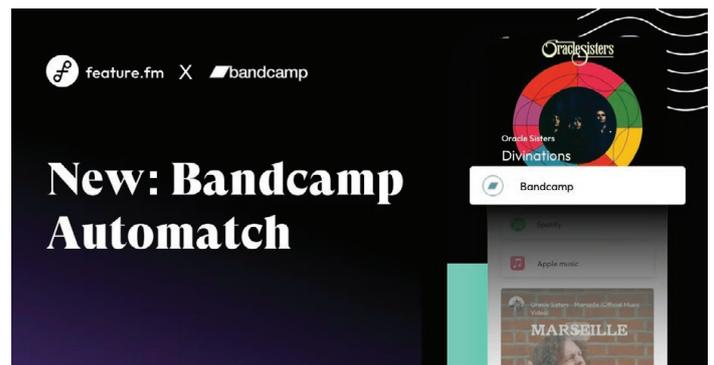
Bandcamp provides artists with tools to build and grow sustainable careers. This includes flexible pricing models such as “pay-what-you-want,” free downloads, fixed pricing and pre-orders. Artists can customise their storefronts, embed players on external websites and communicate directly with fans using built-in messaging and email tools.

Bandcamp Pro offers additional features such as batch uploading, more advanced analytics, targeted fan messaging, custom branding and ad-free video hosting. New promotional integrations, like the [platform's integration with Feature.fm](#) make it easier for artists to guide fans to their Bandcamp stores and drive conversions.

Recently, Bandcamp began testing playlist-sharing, encouraging more organic music discovery through fan-curated lists saying it’s “a modern mixtape: handmade, shareable, and designed to help others discover the artists you love”. Artists also regularly offer limited-edition vinyl, signed items, exclusive demos, and other niche products to super-serve their most dedicated listeners.

Fan & Community Engagement

Bandcamp encourages meaningful connections between fans and artists by creating a community culture. Fans can follow artists and receive email updates for new releases, showcase their purchases in public fan collections and explore music via genre tags, editorial content, and the “Selling Right Now” widget, highlighting real-time global purchases. Community programmes such as Bandcamp Daily and Bandcamp Weekly provide artist features, genre deep dives and scene reports, while initiatives like Black Music Month feature live-streamed interviews and listening parties. Bandcamp has also launched “Bandcamp Notes,” a newsletter that curates music discoveries, interviews and behind-the-scenes stories, helping fans find and support new music directly from creators.

Social Impact: Bandcamp Fridays & Charitable Initiatives

Bandcamp Fridays began in March 2020 as a COVID-19 relief initiative to help artists impacted by the pandemic. On the first Friday of each month, Bandcamp waives its revenue share, directing 100% of sales to artists and labels. As of 2025, these events have raised over \$120 million. The most recent Bandcamp Friday in May 2025 generated \$3.2 million in just 24 hours. The

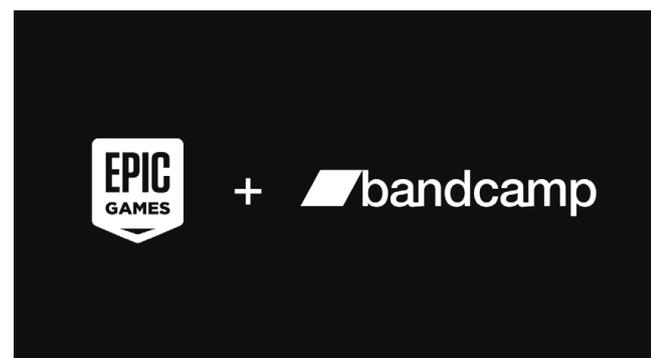

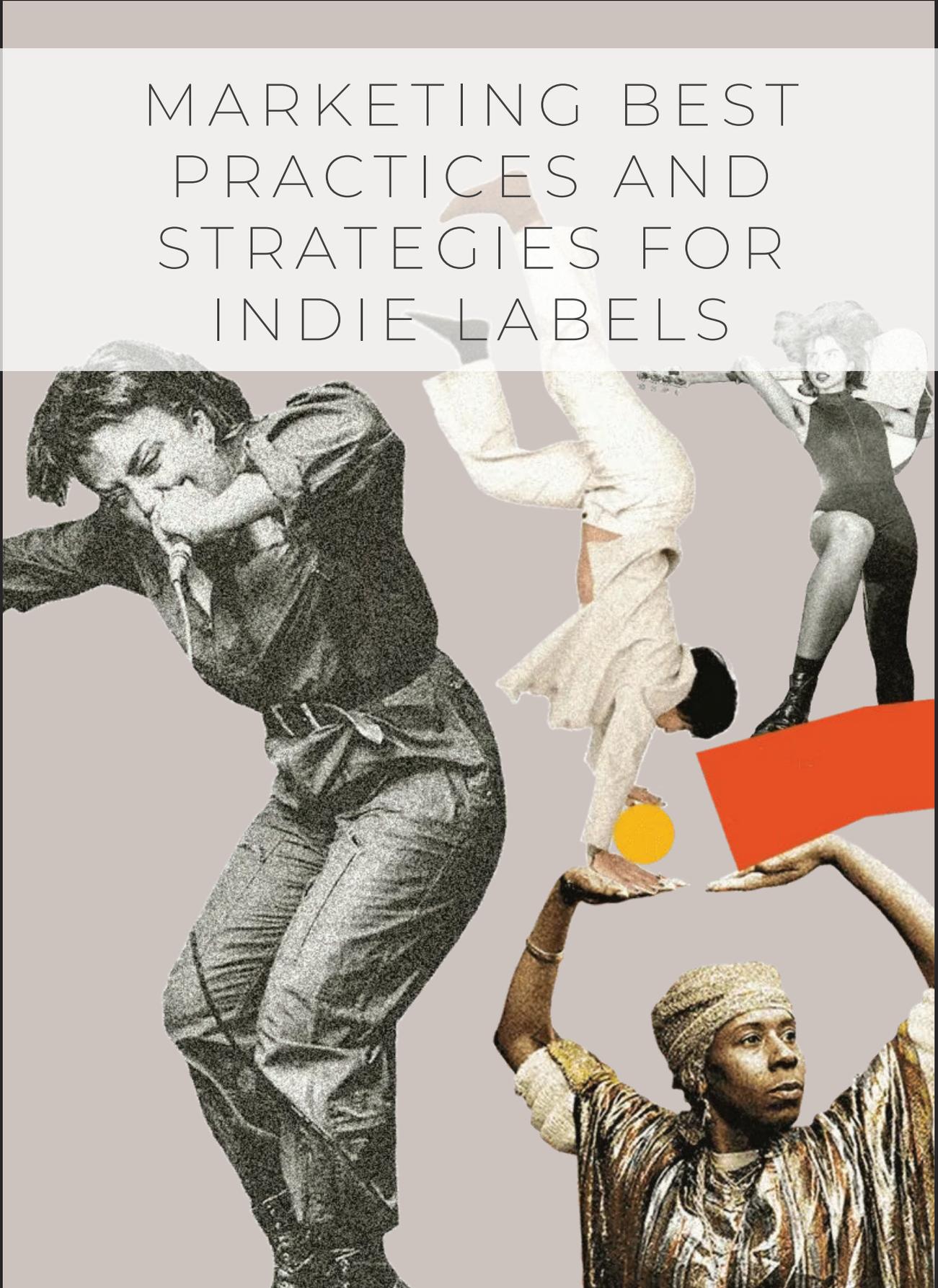

Bandcamp was originally an independent

Bandcamp's future direction. However, Songtradr has maintained that it plans to invest in Bandcamp's artist community, platform development and new payment solutions. With a reported 20% increase in artist earnings and 30% rise in fan engagement, there is now cautious optimism about Bandcamp's future under its new owner.

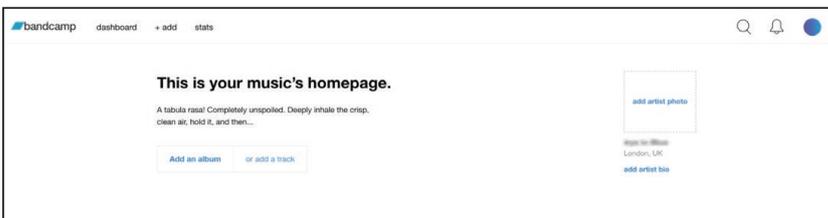

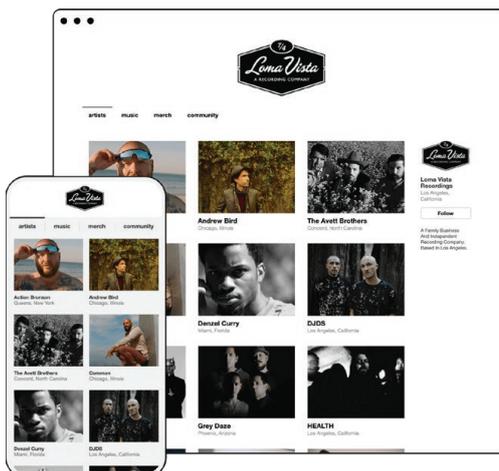
#1 Artist and Label accounts

It's possible to have both [artist](#) and [label](#) accounts on Bandcamp.

Artist accounts are free—Bandcamp is 100% free to use as an artist, though they do offer a Bandcamp Pro subscription (\$5/month for the first year, then \$10/month). The paid Bandcamp Pro artist profile includes advanced features (detailed analytics, private streaming, custom domains, batch uploading, video headers, and deeper messaging tools) which are not available on the free version.

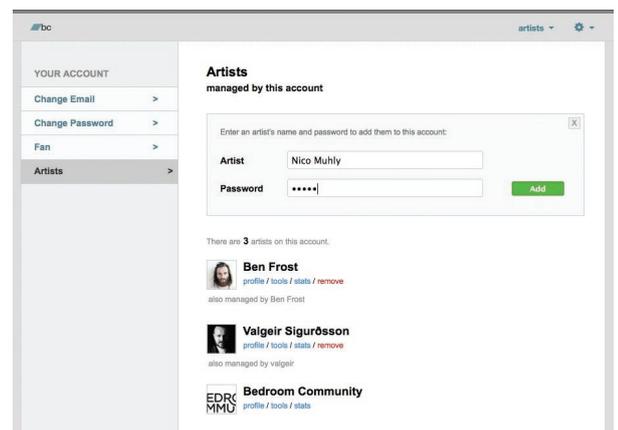


Label accounts are available at \$20/month for up to fifteen artists, or \$50/month for unlimited artists. The layout is similar to an artist page—customisable design, featured releases, and



merch options—but with added features for labels. The homepage can be curated with albums, tracks, merch, livestreams, or whatever is most relevant.

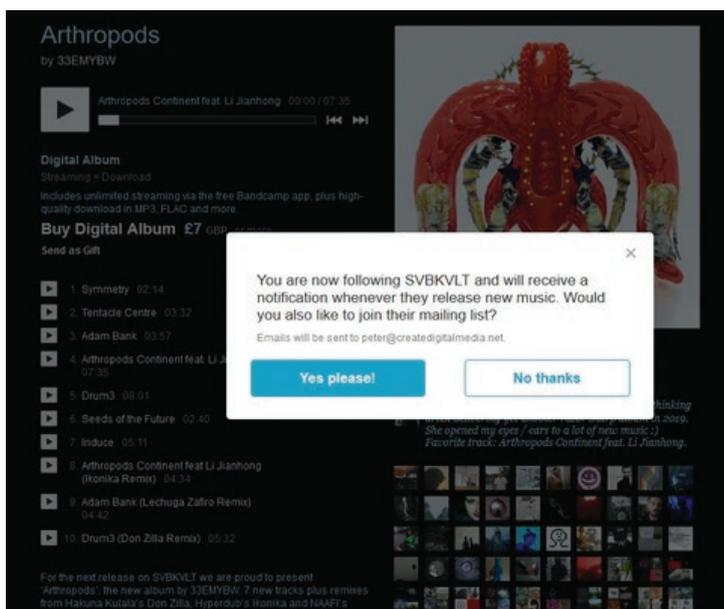
Every artist added under a label account gets a Bandcamp Pro page, giving them access to advanced features while keeping everything connected under the label's brand. All signed artists appear on the label profile, and their releases are automatically linked. It's possible to hide or show artists, or even release music only through the label page (without linking it to an artist profile).



Label accounts also provide access to exportable sales reports, with filters for digital-only or physical-only items. Revenue from specific purchases can be redirected to the label account instead of individual artists. While royalty splits aren't handled automatically through Bandcamp for labels, the structured sales data makes manual accounting more manageable.

To be able to follow an artist or label page and automatically get notified about any updates the fans have to create a **fan account**.

#2 Site Customisation

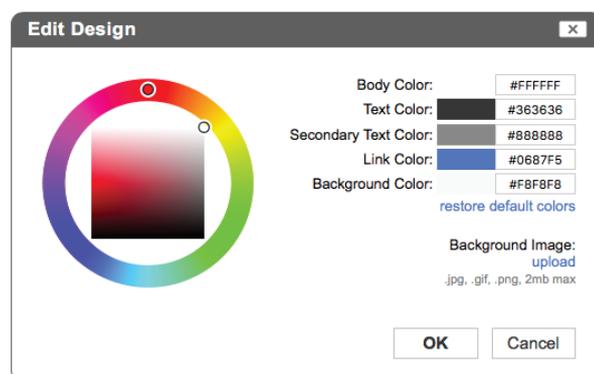
Customisation is the same for both artist and label pages and is key to creating a more personal experience – making fans feel like they’re buying directly at a show/record store. The customisation elements include:

Profile Image

Adding a profile image is an essential part of customization and it helps the fans to recognize who they are purchasing from.

Site Colours and Background

Customised sites stand out and are more memorable for fans - whether it's an artist page or a label profile - helping reinforce brand



identity and create a cohesive visual experience. It is also possible to keep updating the site design to match the aesthetics of new releases and keep it aligned with the artist's "eras".

Bio

Another part of customisation is the option to write a 400-character bio. It's recommended to keep the bio short, covering the main information about the artist/label.

Links to Social Platforms

It's possible to redirect fans to the artist's or label's social media platforms like YouTube or Instagram by inserting a link underneath the bio section. It's not recommended by Bandcamp to redirect fans to other online stores as it might result in lower chances to be featured on [Bandcamp daily](#).

Liner Notes

Liner notes add to the overall interaction experience and can provide biographical context to the project, serving as another touchpoint between the audience and the artist.

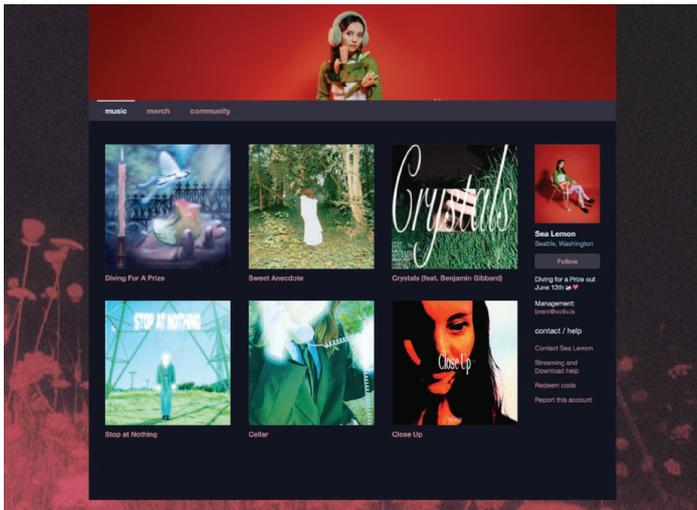

Pricing Options

It's possible to choose between free downloads, fixed pricing and pay-what-you-want, where fans can offer more than the base price.

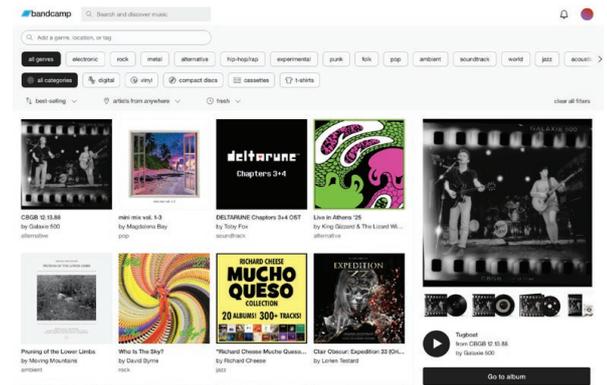

#3 Discoverability

Bandcamp's [Discover](#) feature helps fans find new music through curated recommendations based on tags, genres, formats, and more.

Correctly tagging releases with accurate genres, moods, and styles is essential to ensure music reaches the right audience.



Tags influence where releases appear making them a key tool for visibility. Using Discover effectively connects releases to listeners browsing specific categories, helping grow fanbases organically within Bandcamp's

community-driven ecosystem. Artists and managers should carefully select relevant tags during upload to maximise discoverability.

Band also offers real-time visibility through features like the **"Selling Right Now"** widget.

#4 Physical Merch

A large part of how fans can support artists directly is through merch purchases. Bandcamp reports that merch sales account for half of the total sales on the platform - and this number is growing.

Alternatively, a separate fulfillment system can be integrated through the [Merch API](#).

The platform provides tools for order fulfillment and a [merch backend](#), where managers and teams can view orders, mark items as shipped, search and filter orders, update customer addresses, and [print shipping labels and packing slips](#).

One of Bandcamp's biggest advantages for physical sales - compared to separate webstores - is the platform's potential for organic growth. Because Bandcamp is community-driven, sales can snowball as a result of fan activity.

Here's how the discovery chain works:

1. Fans who follow an artist receive automatic notifications about new releases (including merch).
2. When a fan makes a purchase, their followers are notified via email and their music feed.

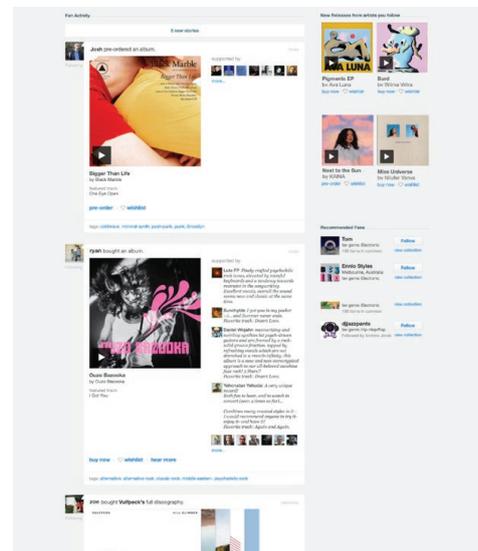

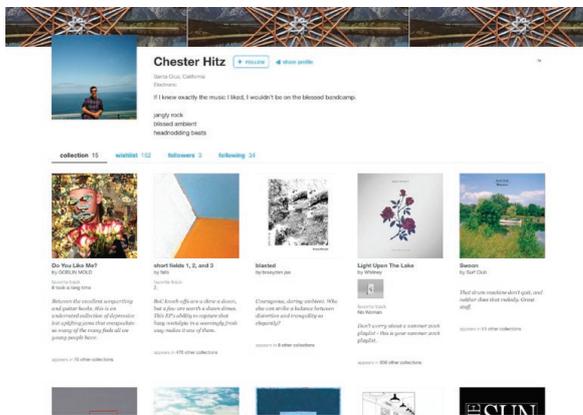

It's possible to grant a fulfillment partner direct access to the merch dashboard, allowing them to handle orders independently without accessing any other parts of the account.

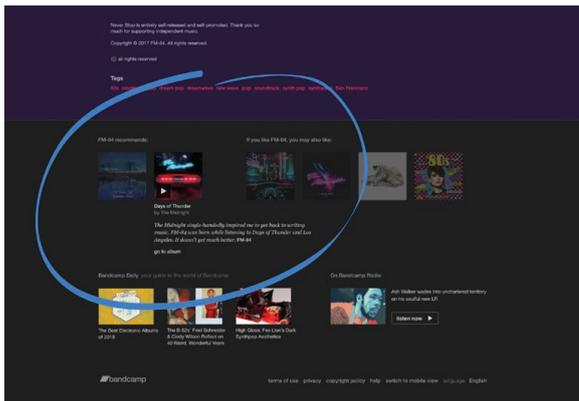

- The release appears in every buyer's **public collection**, increasing visibility.



- It begins showing up in “**people who bought this also bought**” recommendations.



- It can surface in the “recent best-sellers” section of Bandcamp’s **discover** tab - driving additional sales.

Fans are also able to browse merchandise using filters and feature-based search tools, which makes discoverability even more effective.

TIP: Making sure the artist's genre and details

are tagged correctly will greatly improve discoverability through filtering, so it's important to ensure everything is accurate and detailed.



#5 Bundles and Add ons

As an idea to encourage fans to buy merch or physical music, it's possible to include a digital album or track with any physical item on Bandcamp, so that when a fan purchases a physical item, they get instant streaming via Bandcamp apps, as well as an optional high-quality download. Another good opportunity is to introduce **merch bundles** - grouping items together and offering discounts when fans buy multiple merch items at once. **Discount codes** are another way to give fans a good deal while shopping on Bandcamp.

Since Bandcamp notifies followers whenever something new is added, releasing physical products creates a natural moment to re-engage the fanbase. It also streamlines the fan journey - keeping everything in one place without the need to jump between sites.

#6 Messaging and Direct Interactions With Fans

Artists and labels can send **targeted messages** directly to fans through Bandcamp's messaging system. These messages can be personalised and segmented based on fan behavior and preferences, such as:

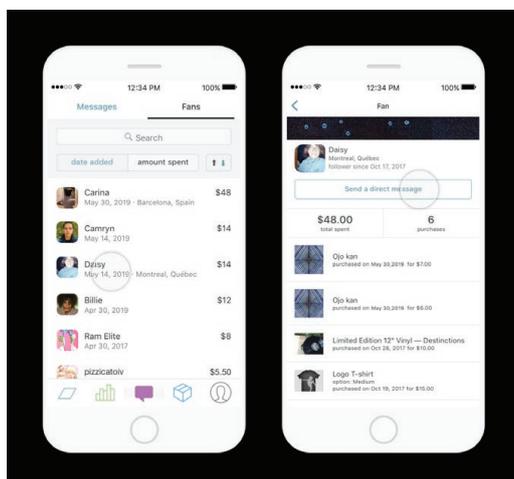
Location-based messages: Reach fans in specific cities or countries, perfect for promoting upcoming tours or local events.

Support level: Target fans who have purchased music, merch, or attended livestreams, rewarding your artist's most dedicated supporters.

Recent purchasers: Send thank you messages or exclusive offers to fans who recently bought your artist's album or merch.

Pre-release announcements: Build anticipation by notifying fans about new releases, exclusive content, or early access opportunities.

This segmentation makes messages more relevant and increases fan engagement rates.



Messaging Ideas

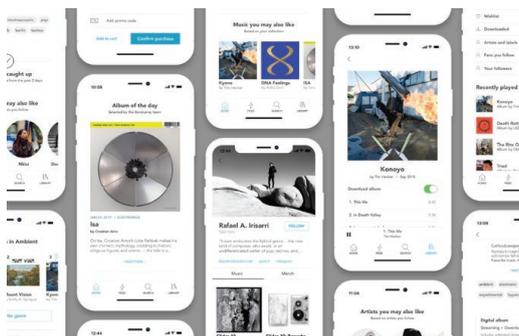
- **Live Stream Announcements:** Promote upcoming paid livestreams or listening parties through direct messaging, making sure fans don't miss out.
- **New Release Alerts:** Notify fans when an album drops, including links to stream or purchase, creating a direct sales boost without relying on external channels.
- **Tour Announcements:** An artist can message fans in a specific city with ticket info and venue details ahead of a show, reaching the local audiences.
- **Exclusive Offers:** Labels can send discount codes or early-bird access links to superfans who have shown strong support, encouraging repeat purchases.
- **Fan Appreciation:** Send personalised thank you notes or shoutouts to fans who have supported financially, deepening the artist-fan relationship.

#7 Bandcamp App for Artists and Labels

The [Bandcamp app](#) for artists and labels is a convenient way to manage the music sales, fan engagement, and order fulfillment directly from mobile devices. Available on both iOS and Android, the app allows users to track real-time sales, manage and fulfill merchandise orders, and communicate directly with fans.

For labels managing multiple artists, the app supports [switching between artist accounts](#) without the need to log in and out repeatedly. The detailed guide on how to do this can be found [here](#).

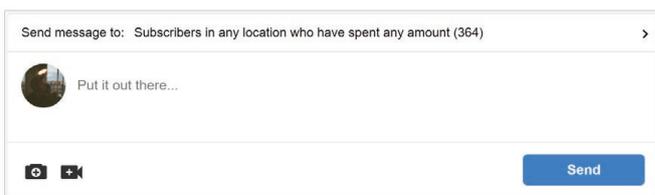


#8 Treating Bandcamp Like Social Media

Bandcamp is a community-driven platform for a reason - and one of the best ways to nurture that community is by treating it like a social media space, where labels and artists actively engage with fans through updates, direct messages, and interaction that goes beyond just releasing music.

Share content directly with fans

Using the [Community tab](#), which functions like a broadcast channel, it is possible to post updates, behind-the-scenes content, or custom messages alongside your release schedule. These updates are delivered via email and in-app notifications, creating a direct line to the fans.



Additionally, **Bandcamp supports private streaming links**, which can be shared with superfans or early supporters. Labels can leverage this for early access drops, sneak peeks,

or to create an exclusive tier of fan engagement before a public release.

Engage publicly

Besides

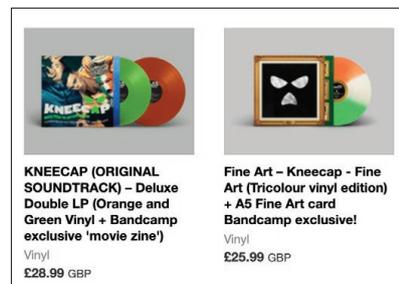
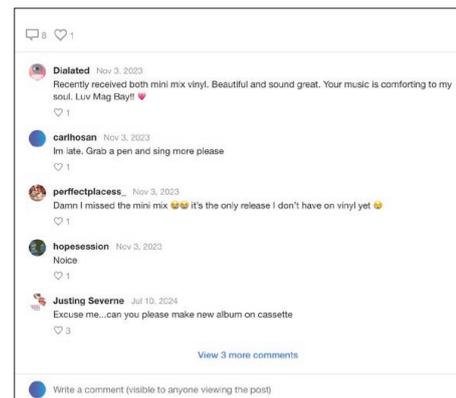
messaging, Bandcamp also supports **comments and fan posts** on album and merch pages, which artists and labels can actively participate in to foster a sense of community. Responding to fan comments or questions creates a personal connection and encourages more interaction and sharing. This real-time engagement helps maintain excitement and loyalty around releases.

Bandcamp exclusives

Bandcamp also supports **exclusive content and merch** that can be made available only through the platform. Labels can use these exclusives as part of a community strategy - offering them to fans who follow the label, subscribe to updates, or engage via messaging.

By actively participating in these interactions, labels foster a **thriving micro-community**

around their roster of artists. This level of engagement is difficult to replicate on other platforms and can be a meaningful differentiator in an increasingly noisy digital landscape.

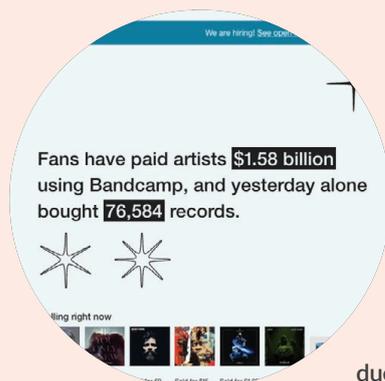


BANDCAMP AND PUBLISHING RESPONSIBILITIES

Bandcamp is primarily a direct-to-fan sales and streaming platform, not a full-service interactive streaming service. This distinction affects how copyright laws apply to its service. Bandcamp passes on revenue from downloads, physical sales, and streaming directly to artists and labels, but this revenue relates only to the sound recording (master royalties). Bandcamp does not hold any publishing licenses and does not manage or pay publishing royalties, including mechanical or performance rights, in any territory. How this affects you, may vary on a country by country basis.

What this means for indie labels:

- **Uploader responsibility for rights:** Anyone uploading music to Bandcamp must either own all necessary publishing rights or be able to administer and pay those rights themselves. This includes paying mechanical royalties on downloads or physical sales and handling all publishing obligations for any streams.
- **PRO/CMO/MRO registration:** When uploading music, songwriters affiliated with collecting societies must be correctly identified. This is a legal safeguard - it does not mean Bandcamp pays publishing. If affiliations are not correctly registered, liability for any claims falls on the artist or label.
- **For downloads and physical sales:** Bandcamp delivers master revenue, but mechanical royalties remain the responsibility of rights holders and



their collecting societies. In Europe, PROs/CMOs/MROs typically collect these if songwriters and collaborators are properly registered and the uploader reports the downloads and sales to the PRO. In the U.S., mechanical royalties are also due but collection must be handled via the

MLC or other mechanisms. For other countries, we recommend checking BandCamp's resources.

• **For streaming on Bandcamp:** enabling streaming can trigger performance and mechanical royalties, but Bandcamp does not pay these. Rights holders are responsible for royalties from:

- Streams provided as an incentive to buy
- Use in playlists or "radio"-style offerings on the service
- Livestreams, listening parties, or locker plays after purchase
- Any other public communication of the music via the service

The responsibility for reporting and distributing them remains entirely with the rights holders and their societies. Unlike platforms such as Spotify or Apple Music, Bandcamp does not have blanket publishing licenses in place for streaming. Bandcamp doesn't cover streaming publishing royalties in Europe, but societies may still be able to collect performance and mechanical royalties depending on local law, and if the use is reported and registered correctly. In the US for example, collection is more fragmented so correctly paying royalties can be more labor-intensive.

Bandcamp Daily

[Bandcamp Daily](#) is the platform's in-house editorial arm - home to in-depth artist interviews, scene reports, Album of the Day write-ups, genre roundups, Label Spotlights, and more. It's a powerful tool for labels to showcase their artists, catalog, and curatorial identity to a global audience. Artists should use the official [form](#) to submit their projects to be considered to Bandcamp Daily, while labels should contact editors directly.



How Labels Can Use Bandcamp Daily

Label Spotlights: Labels with a distinct identity or sound can be featured through long-form "[Label Profile](#)" articles. These pieces often highlight key artists and the ethos behind the imprint.

Scene Reports: If the label is tied to a specific geographic or [genre-based scene](#), your releases might be included in city or region-focused reports.

Themed Roundups: Releases may be included in monthly or genre-based roundups such as

Tips for Getting Featured

Submit Early

Bandcamp recommends submitting to Bandcamp Daily **8 weeks before** the release.

Keep it Bandcamp

Provide a **Bandcamp link** only - either private or draft mode. Don't send SoundCloud, Dropbox, or Spotify links. Also Bandcamp **strongly discourages linking to other stores or platforms** within your release materials so it's advised to frame the release as something that lives **primarily on Bandcamp**.

Make Smart Use of Bandcamp Features

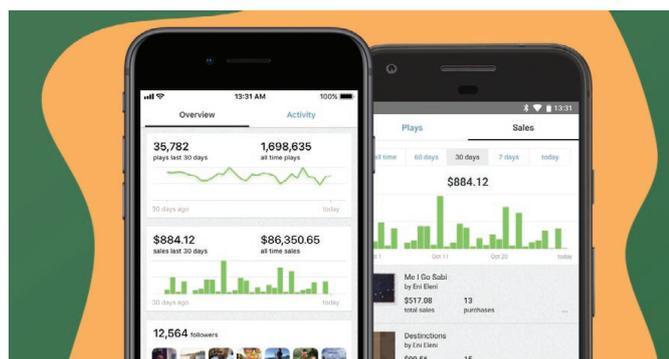
Editors prefer releases that show off the best of Bandcamp including strong **visual presentation**, effective use of **tags and metadata**, **artist bios** and **liner notes** and integrated **merch bundles** or limited editions.

Tell a Story

Share the creative, cultural, or emotional **narrative behind the release**. Avoid submitting just a press release. Add a compelling copy to your "*About this album*" section as well.

Leveraging Data

Bandcamp's built-in analytics - accessible via the desktop and the [Bandcamp Artist & Label App](#) - provides the access to the real-time, purchase-driven data showing *who* is buying,

how and when. The data shows what truly drives purchases - not just engagement - in real time, giving artists and labels valuable insights they can use to fine-tune release strategies, strengthen fan connections, and increase sales.

What is possible to track:

From the Stats tab in the Bandcamp Artist App (or on desktop via your dashboard), it is possible to access:

– Sales Sources

Navigate to: **Stats** → **Sales** → **Select a release**

A breakdown of how fans discovered and purchased your artist's music will be displayed, including direct traffic (from your email newsletter, social posts, etc.), Bandcamp Discover feature, Bandcamp search, External websites and blogs, Bandcamp Daily or editorial features and social media referrals (e.g., Twitter, Facebook, Instagram).

This data is useful to understand what channels are driving actual purchases, not just clicks or streams. For example, if most of purchases are coming from direct traffic, it means the existing fanbase is already strong. But if Bandcamp Discover or editorial features are a leading source, it suggests high platform visibility - a sign that the artist is tagging their music well and benefiting from community engagement.

– Top Countries & Cities

Understanding **geographical fan data** could help to plan where to promote tour dates or livestreams, localise merch offerings (e.g.,

exclusive region-based drops) and tailor social media ads or messages by city or country.

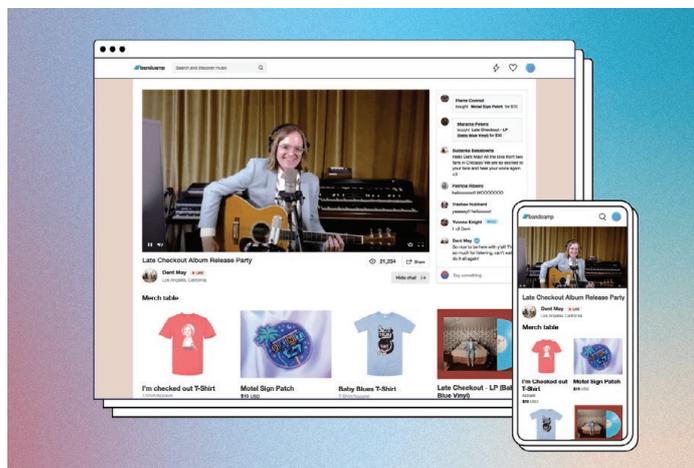
– Format-Based Sales

You can view what **formats your fans prefer** - whether digital, vinyl, cassette, CD, or merch bundles. This allows for hyper-targeted promotions.

Example: If you see high vinyl purchases from Germany, consider messaging that segment when launching a limited-edition pressing.

Livestreams

Another offering from Bandcamp is the ability to host free or ticketed livestreams, which is a convenient option to perform live shows, concerts, or special one-off events directly for the fans. These livestreams are integrated into the Bandcamp platform, meaning there's no need for third-party tools or redirections - fans can discover, buy tickets, and watch the performance all in one place.



Artists have full control over the ticket pricing, and Bandcamp takes a 10% fee from sales.

Once a ticket is purchased, fans receive a private link to the stream and can tune in from any device. During the event, there's a real-time chat feature that allows for interaction between fans, and artists can also join the chat to engage with their audience, shout out fans, or even take questions during the set.

Additional features include:

- **Merch shelf integration:** Fans watching the livestream can browse and purchase merch from the artist's Bandcamp store without leaving the event page.
- **Tipping option:** Viewers can optionally tip during the event, giving another way to support the artist directly.
- **Post-show replay:** Artists can choose to make the livestream available for replay for a limited time, increasing accessibility for fans in different time zones.

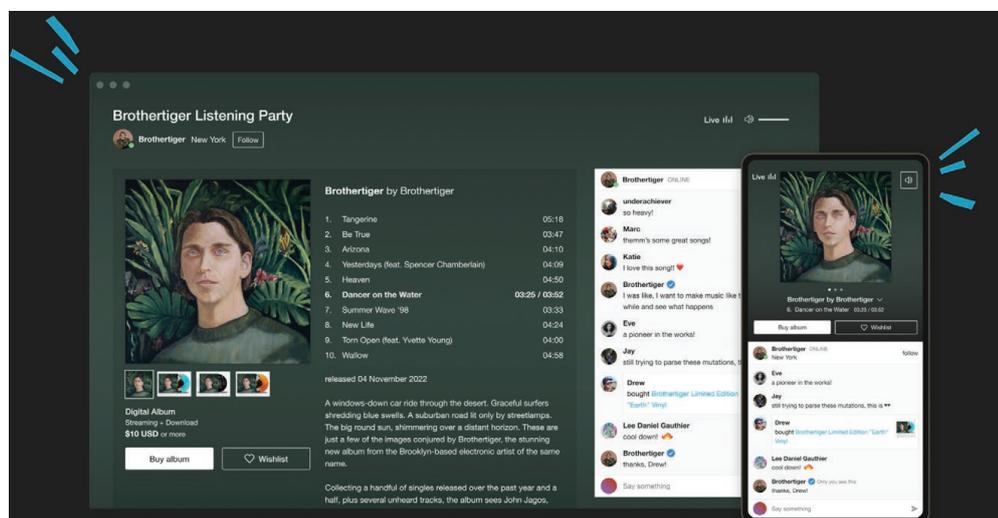

Listening Parties

[Bandcamp's Listening Parties](#) let artists stream a full album or EP live to fans at a scheduled time. Fans can pre-order or buy the release in any format directly from the event page. During the stream, the entire album plays once, accompanied by the full tracklist and liner notes for added context.

Similar to the live streaming functionalities the listening party has a live chat feature that enables fans and artists to interact, discuss the music, and share insights in real time. Artists can customise the event with header images and background colors to match their release's aesthetic.

Listening Parties generate buzz by creating a shared listening experience that drives sales and engagement. The event URL can be promoted in advance, and after the stream, the album remains available for regular streaming while the chat transcript stays accessible for fans who join late or want to revisit the discussion.

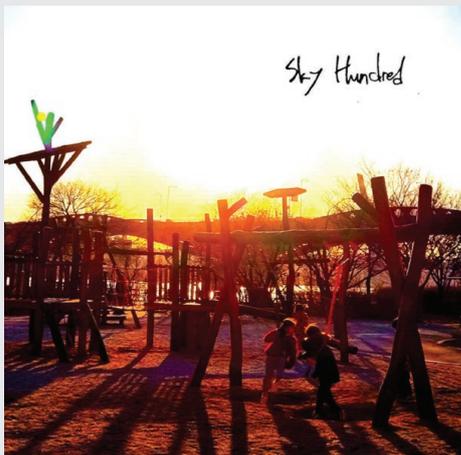

Parannoul is a Seoul-based solo artist in the shoegaze genre. Since his emergence in 2020, he has quietly built a global following while remaining anonymous. He keeps a low public profile, communicating almost entirely through music and text on Bandcamp.



Rather than seek traditional music industry validation, he has cultivated a devoted audience through word of mouth on Reddit, Twitter, Discord and of course the artist-first tools available on Bandcamp. His 2021 and 2023 albums received growing acclaim but the 2024 Bandcamp-first release, *Sky Hundred*, marked a turning

point in his international recognition, visibility, and monetisation.

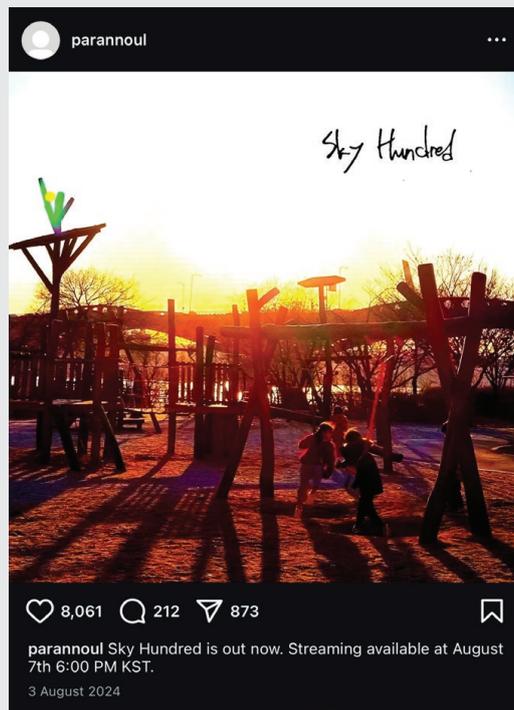

Strategic Surprise Release

Without prior notice, *Sky Hundred* appeared on Parannoul's Bandcamp page. There were no teasers, interviews, or PR outreach. The stark cover art, lack of description and absence of social media engagement aligned with his long standing method of letting the music speak. This approach built a sense of intimacy between the artist and the audience, making fans feel part of a shared discovery. Within 24 hours, the album reached Bandcamp's "Best-Selling Shoegaze" and "New and Notable" lists.



Viral Discovery

Parannoul's core audience spread across Reddit, Discord servers and Twitter acted as promoters. On r/indieheads, multiple threads reviewed the album, linking directly to the Bandcamp page and urging others to support it directly. Redditors praised the record.

Bandcamp's fan collection further amplified visibility: as users bought the album, it appeared in their public collections, boosting peer-to-peer recommendations. Some fans added brief personal reviews, community-generated smart links, Tumblr posts, and playlist embeds that drove thousands of impressions outside of commercial advertising.

Editorial Amplification

Within days of release, *Sky Hundred* was spotlighted by:



- **Paste Magazine** – included in "Best Albums of August 2024"
- **PopMatters** – listed among "Top 10 Shoegaze Albums of 2024"

Importantly, these features followed and didn't lead the fan activity. Parannoul's Bandcamp-exclusive drop was a fan-driven hit before the media caught on, demonstrating that Bandcamp can be the launchpad.

Vinyl & Premium Bundling

Roughly one week after its digital release, Parannoul opened a limited vinyl preorder directly through Bandcamp. Each order came with exclusive high-res digital files, an

unreleased bonus track, a digital zine designed by the artist.

The first 500 copies sold out in under two days. A second pressing was announced within a month and fans in Europe and North America reported long shipping wait times indicating demand far exceeded initial supply.



Streaming Release + Catalogue Surge

On August 7, *Sky Hundred* arrived on Spotify, Apple Music and other DSPs. Rather than stumping Bandcamp revenue, this increased Parannoul's reach. The early buzz helped the album land on multiple editorial playlists.

Even more notably, new fans began digging through his Bandcamp back catalogue, purchasing earlier albums. This long-tail boost is one of Bandcamp's strengths, when fans purchase music, they explore entire catalogues, which is less common on DSPs.

Results & Key Learnings

Parannoul's *Sky Hundred* release is a unique fusion of artistic freedom, financial success, and grassroots cultural influence. The album gained editorial attention because of the positive reception it received from listeners, not because

of media coverage. The story was followed, not the other way around, by publications including PopMatters and Paste Magazine.

This bottom-up momentum demonstrates one of Bandcamp's main advantages. Fans may increase an artist's awareness more efficiently than sponsored advertising when they are empowered to support and spread the music they love. Bandcamp can act as a launchpad and a sustainable artistic ecosystem, as demonstrated by Parannoul's ability to transport vinyl across countries, create high-margin digital sales, and spark renewed interest in his back catalogue all without compromising creative independence. Fans paid directly for downloads, high-resolution files, and limited-edition vinyl during Parannoul's high-revenue debut window thanks to the Bandcamp-first strategy. Crucially, this took place prior to the album's release on streaming services.

- 1. Use Bandcamp's ecosystem deliberately:** From fan notifications to exclusive bundles, the platform rewards engaged artist-fan strategies.
- 2. Let fans lead the momentum:** Authentic releases can grow organically when empowered by the right tools and community.
- 3. Delay DSP distribution** to capitalise on early sales and foster urgency.
- 4. Global DIY artists can break through** using Bandcamp as a foundational reach, sales, and reputation platform.
- 5. High-impact campaigns don't require high spending** - they need credible artistry, effective use of Bandcamp tools, and active communities.

CONCLUSION

This primer has provided independent labels with an overview of how to best leverage Bandcamp as part of their D2C strategy. Bandcamp serves as a crucial platform for independent labels and artists, as it fosters direct fan relationships and offers significant revenue opportunities outside traditional streaming models. The platform is known for its “Bandcamp Fridays”, during which it waives its fees, leading to over \$140 million in sales for artists and labels since 2020, and over \$1.5 billion in lifetime payouts.

There are various discovery pathways for independent artists and labels, such as via Bandcamp’s editorial opportunities, community tools such as fan collections as well as real-time visibility through the “Selling Right Now” widget and exploration by tags, genres, and formats.

This “world’s largest superfan platform” facilitates diverse monetization avenues, including direct-to-fan sales with “Pay What You Want” that often surpass streaming earnings, the sale of Physical Goods like vinyl, cassettes, and clothing (comprising 50% of the platform’s revenue), and Live Events like ticketed streaming via Bandcamp Live, where artists retain nearly all revenue post fees.

Having acquired Bandcamp from Epic Games, Songtradr plans to further develop the platform through investments in growth. Songtradr President Bryan Biniak has promised to introduce more tools for artists and labels, improve discovery opportunities, and build community features. Songtradr is actively investing in the community, the product, and new payment solutions to strengthen the platform. These developments have already led to a 20% increase in artist earnings and a 30% rise in fan engagement.
